Initial Project Presentations
In class on Feb 26 and Mar 5

Each group should prepare and present a short 10-15min presentation about their project idea. I realize that your projects are in a very early stage of development, so I'm really looking for some basic information about your project idea. The plan is to have you present your idea to the class, and get feedback from me and from the class about your ideas.

- For future presentations you will be required to have each team member share the responsibility for presenting.
 - For this initial presentation you can have everybody on the team speak, or you can designate a team spokesperson or two. It's up to you.
- The presentation should be 10-15 min long and cover the following:
 - Introduce the team
 - Top-level description of your project
 - What will it do?
 - What will your demo look like?
 - What special parts do you think you'll need
 - What are the HW and SW aspects of the project as you're currently thinking about it
- You should present your project in class using Powerpoint, Keynote, PDF, or some other presentation technology.
 - You can use your own laptop if you like, or you can email me your presentation in advance and I'll have it on my laptop for you.
 - If you do this, realize that Powerpoint sometimes gets confused if you are using fonts on your PC that I don't have on my Mac. If you're using strange fonts, you might want to output as PDF and send me that.

I'll make a schedule for which team speaks when as soon as I see how many teams there are. If you're doing a clinic or an individual thesis, you still need to make a presentation about the clinic or thesis idea.
